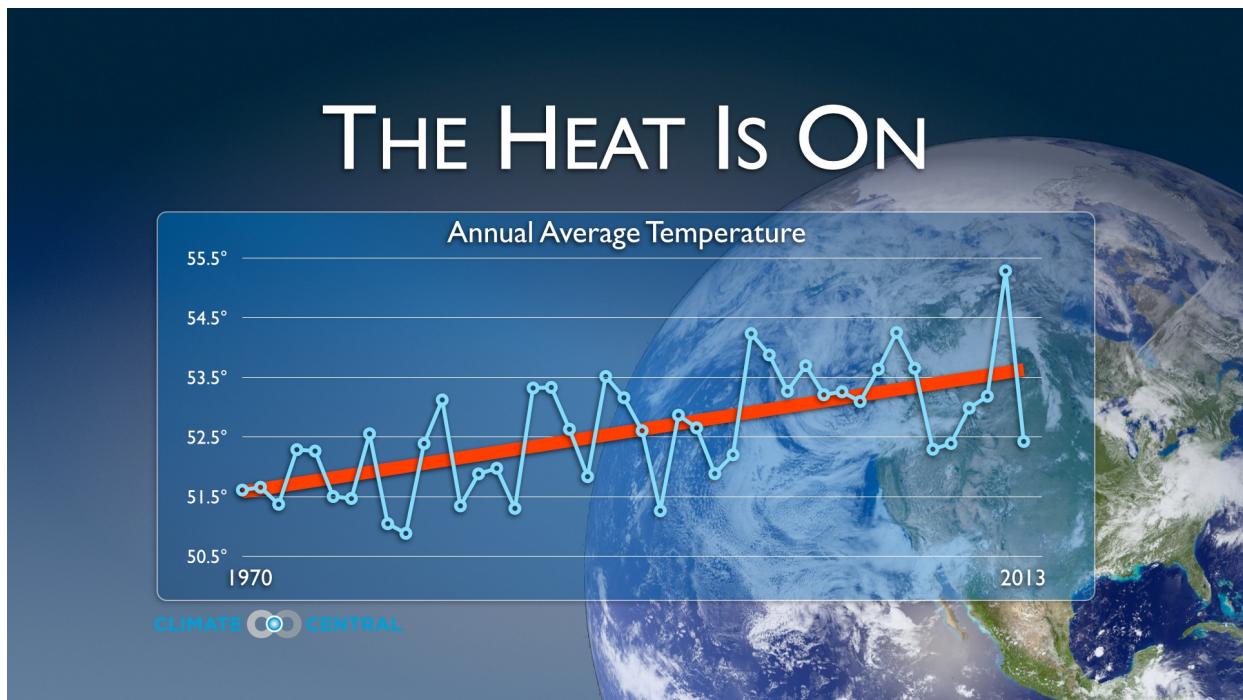


## Fact 10: Global warming is a long-term trend; it doesn't mean next year will always be warmer than this year

- In most parts of the U.S., the temperature warms from February to August, then cools from August to February. But that doesn't mean May is always warmer than April, that next year will be warmer than this year, or that there is no underlying trend.
