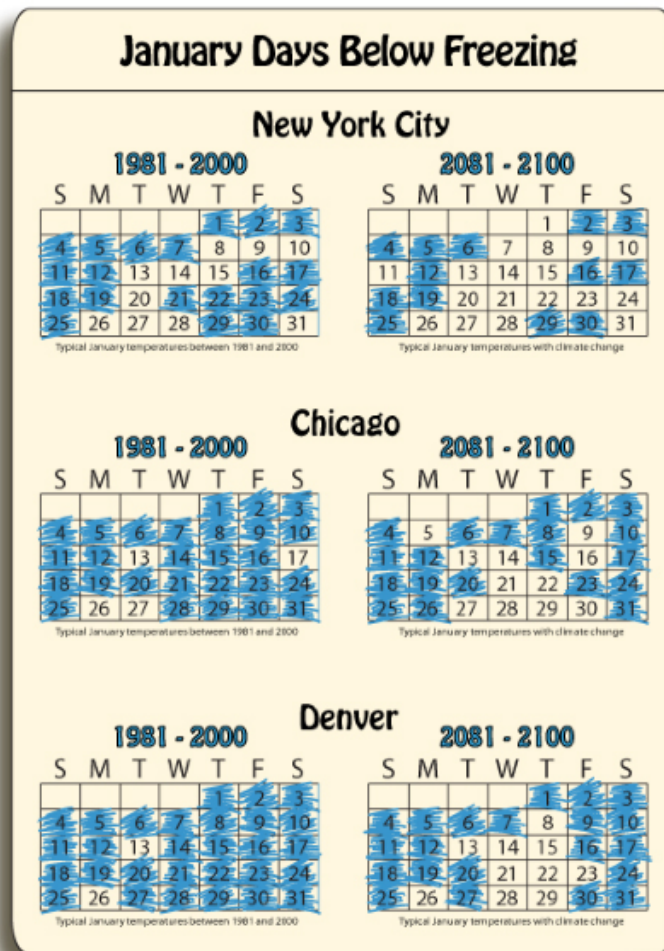


## Fact 9: Frost and snowstorms will still happen in a warmer world

- Minnesota and Maine and Iowa and Pennsylvania and pretty much any place that gets ice and snow will see average winter temperatures increase over the next 100 years. But these are just averages: some days will still plunge below freezing, just not as often. To eliminate below-freezing days entirely, the average winter temperature would have to go a *lot* higher than any climate model is projecting
